TO THE VOTERS OF BRIDGTON:

You are hereby notified that a Maine School Administrative District No. 61 referendum election will be held at Bridgton Town Hall, 26 North High Street, in the Town of Bridgton at 8:00 A.M. on May 20, 2014 for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1A: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 1: Do you favor authorizing the board of directors of Maine School Administrative District No. 61 to issue bonds or notes in the name of this district for a minor capital project in an amount not to exceed \$135,824 for water system improvements, including storage, pumping, and treatment improvements, at the Songo Locks School?

The voting on Article 1 shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls will be opened immediately after the election of the Moderator following commencement of the meeting at 8:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
