Completed Work over the Previous Two Weeks

- Contracted with soil scientist for evaluation of the proposed Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) parcel;
- Contracted with Aerial Survey & Photo of Norridgewock, Maine who has engaged Plisga and Day to provide ground control and location survey for sewer collection system and the WWTF parcel;
- Met with Town Officials and Owner of proposed WWTF parcel to discuss land acquisition and access;
- Coordinated with HEB and Milone & MacBroom on sewer design to be included in streetscape work;
- Provided Bond Counsel with revenue projections;
- Provided Bond Counsel with drawdown schedule;
- Contacted DEP to discuss loan/principal forgiveness conditions and had them revise the agreement;
- Continued discussion with Bond Council regarding interim and permanent financing;
- Discussed anticipated water project with Water District's Engineer;
- Attended public hearing on wastewater license.

- Confirm survey schedule with Aerial Survey;
- Review soils work on WWTF parcel;
- Attend workshop with Water District and Town; and
- Review streetscape surveys to add proposed sewers to the Work and;
