Status Report

This memo is a status report of the Project Team's efforts on the Town of Bridgton's Wastewater Treatment Facility & Sewer Collection System Project and describes:

- Highlights of the work completed over the previous three weeks;
- Identification of the work anticipated over the next two weeks;

- Schedule update.

Completed Work over the Previous Two Weeks

- On site soils work completed by Longview Partners on December 13th on the proposed Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) parcel;
- Received survey from HEB and Milone & MacBroom for design of sewer to be included in streetscape work;
- Submitted for re-licensing of existing Wastewater Systems to DEP after public hearing input;
- Provided response to comments raised at the public hearing regarding license requirements; and
- Contacted Sawyer Engineering regarding boundary survey for proposed WWTF parcel.

Anticipated Work over the Next Two Weeks

- Confirm local survey firm selection with Aerial Survey;
- Review soils report on proposed WWTF parcel, expected January 7th;
- Attend workshop with Water District and Town on January 23rd;
- Review streetscape surveys to add proposed sewers to the Work;
- Develop Fats, Oil and Grease (FOG) flyer for use with commercial users;
- Set up Payment for initial Aerial Survey Longview Partners' bills prior to interim financing being in place; and
- Contact geotechnical firms to secure boring and geotechnical services.

Outstanding Issues

- Securing site for proposed WWTF.
