Completed Work over the Previous Three Weeks

- Confirming local survey firm selection with Aerial Survey;
- Initial review of soils report on proposed WWTF parcel;
- Attended workshop with Water District and Town on January 14th;
- Reviewed streetscape surveys and added proposed sewers to the streetscape plans;
- Set up payment for initial Aerial Survey and Longview Partners' bills prior to interim financing being in place; and
- Prepared list of streets including pavement quantities that will be affected by Sewer project for use by the Town.

Anticipated Work over the Next Two Weeks

- Continue review of soils work;
- Develop Fats, Oil and Grease (FOG) flyer for use with commercial users;
- Receive topo survey of projected WWTF parcel; and
- Contact geotechnical firms to secure boring and geotechnical services.

Outstanding Issues

- Securing site for proposed WWTF.
