9. Approval 4-0 to accept attorney's changes for the Ordinance to Regulate Automobile Graveyards, Junkyards and Automobile Recycling Businesses to go to the BOS.
10. Approval 4-0 to accept attorney's changes for the Bicycle Ordinance to go to the BOS. Approval 4-0 to keep Bicycle Ordinance.
