 - How can the language be made more succinct and understandable without detriment to the legal wording?
- Goal that the Consumer Fireworks Use Ordinance, Disorderly House Ordinance, and Ordinance Controlling Nudity in Commercial or Business Activities Not Requiring a Special Amusement Permit will be ready for presentation to the Select Board for January 2020.
- At next meeting continue discussion of Ordinance Controlling Nudity in Commercial or Business Activities Not Requiring a Special Amusement Permit.
