Well, the weather is certainly starting to turn here in November isn't it?!
Below is just a sampling of all of the great work the crew has been doing this month.

Election time came & went:

- The guys built new posts for barriers for the election
- Set up and tore down all of the election paraphernalia




Lights, lights and more lights:

- Repaired the lights at the monument at the top of Main hill
- Put up all of the Christmas lights throughout town



Down on Main Street:

- Took down all of the flags
- Put up brackets and hung all of the snowflakes 
- Did miscellaneous prepping for the snow that is bound to come very soon!
- Did the usual miscellaneous daily chores and maintenance work

Meanwhile, at the Municipal Building:

- The cracks were sealed in the walkway at the Town Office
- We painted the light poles

Cemetery Work:

- Completed leaf blowing
- Had 3 burials

Parks, Beaches, Ballfield:

- Winterized the ballfield bathroom
- Rebuilt pump for Woods Pond restrooms
- Removed the remaining town docks and stored for the winter
- Worked on and implemented a new Lake Levels policy for the Dams
- Put granite streetscape sign in at Dam Park

And in other news ...

- Put new metal siding on the Town Garage
- Installed new GFCI at Community Center Garage
- Painted the salt shed
- Put Jersey barriers at the Transfer Station demo cans
- Fixed the urinal at the Town Garage
- Installed new TP dispensers at the Town Hall
- Cut back the brush in West Bridgton
- Unplugged the culverts on Pond Road
- Finished putting up all the salt / sand in preparation for winter
- Repaired and prepped trucks and plows for winter
- Sanded for the first time this season!
