Monthly Report for Month of June 2021

Personnel- No new members however we have a couple of folks that have taken out applications and we expect those to be returned shortly. Training classes have been sharply curtailed recently due to COVID restrictions , however classes are beginning to be held again and members have been asking to go to various classes as they are announced.

Budget- The department finished the year at approximately 82% of the budget expended. A couple of lines that were significantly reduced were payroll and heating oil. Payroll was reduced primarily due to a large decrease in training sessions, both department and outside training, due to COVID restrictions. Fuel oil for heat was also down due to a warm winter, fewer trainings and not a lot of structure fires during the cold months.

Apparatus- The new Squad truck continues to be a benefit to the department and is relieving some of the wear and tear on our larger apparatus.

Buildings- New automatic standby generators have been ordered for both West and North Stations. The generator for South will be completed in FY 22.
