



Bridgton Public Works Department Monthly Activity Report for June 2021



About Town ... Road Crew

- Have been hauling gravel, repairing culverts, shaping shoulders, trimming and ditching all around town.
- Patched areas of road surface at the Transfer Station.
- Fixed Stop Sign on Sam Ingalls Road.
- Cut back bamboo, picked up dead trees and brush in various locations including Sandy Creek Park.
- Installed speed limit signs on Willis Park Road, picked up brush and swept out all the dirt.
- Have been fixing signs in and around town.
- Fixed a water issue at Zion Hill Road.
- Graveled Monk Road.
- Mowed the Transfer Station landfill.
- Repaired wash outs in various locations.
- Swept Main Street and Depot multiple times.
- Installed gate at Highland Lake dam.
- Finished Evans Rd with Rip Rap.
- Fixed the light pole by the Breakroom on Main Street.
- Removed a tree on Chadbourne Hill Road.



About Town ... Parks Crew

- Repaired cement on a cemetery plot at Forest Hills.
- Refinished a bench at Ryerson Park.
- Refinished flag light at Farragut Park.
- Refinished benches – town common.
- Tallied up needs and placed orders for the lumber and supplies for picnic tables.
- Fixed the flag light at Ryerson Park.
- Capped off open drain pipes at the Woods Pond bathroom.



Lakes & Ponds ...

- Keeping up with cleanliness at the beaches & bathrooms – weekend rotations are in place.
- Household trash was piling up at Highland Lake beach so the trash containers were removed. Carry in / carry out should avoid an overabundance of household trash being left at the beaches.

Cemeteries ...

- We have had numerous burials taking place due to winter passings and COVID restrictions holding things up in the past. More coming up in August.
- Road crew helped with mowing the cemetery at Kansas Road and dug a grave at the S.High Street Cemetery.
