Completed Work over the Previous Three Weeks

- Provided refreshed construction map to Town for weeks July 19th, July 26th, and August 2nd;

- Review 2022 draft road and storm drainage plan with Town;
- Submit draft sidewalk existing status plan;
- Attended Bid opening for WWTF and Pump Stations on July 27th at 1pm; and
- Attended Select Board Meeting on July 27th to discuss sewer extension project.

Anticipated Work over the Next Two Weeks

- Submit 2022 draft road and storm drainage plans to Sargent for pricing;
- Update draft letter describing specifications required for local contractors to work with businesses and residents for connection installations;
- Meet with Town to discuss drainage improvements to State aid roads;
- Kick off PER and ER work for sewer extension project funding;
- Complete design of road and drainage work;
- Provide refreshed construction map to Town for weeks August 10th and August 17th;
- Meet with Apex to discuss cost reduction for WWTF and Pump Station Project; and
- Incorporate local contractor list into connection installation letter.
