- Work with Town to discuss holding tanks for Lakewood Commons;
- Submit PER and ER to Town for review;
- Submit comments on draft discharge license to Town and DEP;
- Connect with GPCOG (or other agency) to complete EDA's application process;
- Meet with Town to discuss drainage improvements to State aid roads; and
- Work with Apex on proposed schedule for WWTF work.

Future Work



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- Update draft letter describing specifications required for local contractors to work with businesses and residents for connection installations once local contractor list provided; and
- Discuss potential for additional funding for WWTF with RD once DEP involvement is known.
