Parks Crew & Wastewater

- Continuing clean up in preparation for summer
- 30-day notices sent out; Billed out quarterly sewer accounts
- Set up ballfield for games
- Read and documented fuel & pump station readings
- Installed docks at Highland Beach
- Two past due sewer accounts were sent to lien
- Jacob started working with Lucia
- Trash picked up throughout town as per usual schedule
- Freshened up lacrosse fields
- Safety training handouts provided to Public Works, Parks & T.S. employees. Done monthly.
- Picnic tables set out at Highland Beach
- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- Parks were all mowed
- Sent out septic tank pumping reminders to all residents that are due throughout the remainder of the year
- Trimmed around Munchkin Park

About Town ... Road Crew

- Installed new culvert on Adams Pond Road
- Unplugged other culverts from the work of very busy beavers
- Hauled and spread gravel – several roads
- Graded / back-dragged – several roads
- Ditching
- Foreman's truck serviced
- Shorey Park Bridge work started and is on-going
- Smoothed in-town roads with calcium
- Swept roads; cleaned up intersections

Lakes & Ponds ...

- Continued to document and publish the lake levels on the Public Works web page
- All town docks have been installed

Cemeteries ...

- Have started up on burials during the month of May
- Continued usual maintenance, mowing and cleaning of all cemeteries
- Accomplished a great deal of leaf collection and removal in all cemeteries
- Put out the flowers on all perpetual care lots

Transfer Station ...

- For the month of May, the Transfer Station has gotten increasingly busier. Compost sales as well as sticker sales have increased, as well as everything else.
- Scales maintenance and calibration done by Maine Scale in May. Pumped 12,000 gallons of water out of it.
- Billed out all Transfer Station accounts
- Had an incident with an employee hitting a customer's truck loading compost. Police were called and all proper reports have been completed.
- Did the compactor clean-out for preventative maintenance. Took 2 yds plus of waste out of each side from inside the machines.
- Bottle room collection reminder mailed out
- Continuing to monitor and make sure those vehicles entering the Transfer Station do have current stickers.
- Monthly report posted to the website
- Sent out 18 cans of MSW, 9 cans of single sort recycling, 12 cans of demo debris and 5 cans of metal for a total of 44 hauls from North Country Recycling.
- Continued with the normal job of cleaning the facility and serving the residents of Bridgton.
