



Bridgton Public Services Department Monthly Activity Report for August 2022



Parks Crew & Wastewater

- Weekly maintenance/mowing/clean-up of parks
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; Billed out quarterly sewer accounts
- Parks picked up and disposed of old wooden bridges from the Pondicherry Park project
- Wastewater read and documented (weekly) the fuel & pump station readings and ground maintenance was completed around pump stations
- Everyone received a walk-through of the Ham Complex in preparation for taking the facility over
- Ham fields were mowed and trimmed
- Wastewater assisted Sargent with a water break on Wayside
- Safety training provided to Public Works, Parks & T.S. employees. Done monthly.
- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- Continued to follow up on septic tank pumping reminders
- Wastewater responded to a call from 292 Main Street (Subway) that turned out to be an in the building issue
- Parks dragged the ballfields at Ham and Lower Main trying to remove unwanted grass from the infield.
- Repaired the deck at the amphitheater in Pondicherry Park

About Town ... Road Crew

- Two new employees started with us in Public Works – Chris Lappin & Anthony Criscitelli. Welcome!
- Set up for Police Appreciation Day
- Removed pavement and regraded 1,000 feet of road – various roads
- Installed 500 feet of culvert
- Assisted in finishing Pondicherry's new trail
- Tree cleanups on Milbrook and Hawk Lane.
- Moved all light poles into shop to be painted
- Picked up brush and hauled gravel

Lakes & Ponds ...

- Continued to document and publish the lake levels on the Public Works web page

- Unfortunately, we had a fire that burned down the bathrooms at Highland Lake Beach.
- Port-o-Potties were ordered to replace the bathrooms for the time being.
- Continued maintenance at the beaches, along with septic pumping throughout the season

Cemeteries ...

- Continued usual maintenance, mowing and cleaning of all cemeteries
- Stood up and repaired stones at Sandy Creek and Glines cemeteries
- Trimmed overhanging branches in South High and Forest Hills cemeteries
- Stood a stone back up at Buzzwell cemetery that was hit by a tree branch

Transfer Station ...

- Constant cleaning and organizing of the grounds
- The store continues to do well, as the whole facility has been extremely busy for the month of August. We have noticed a slight slow down in the last week due to schools reopening, but we are still busier than in the past.
- Constant can changing – 28 MSW, 17 SS recycling, 8 Demo, and 5 Metal for a total of 58 cans out of the Transfer Station for the month of August.
- We have called Bob's Tire more than once. They keep telling me their dispatcher is going to call, but so far, has not.
- We will be working hard to get TV's and electronics boxed up and shipped out ASAP.
