The monthly report for the month of September 2022, from the Bridgton Fire Department.

Personnel: The department has received a resignation from Ed Pontribriand. Ed is a seasonal employee of the United States Forest Service and is gone from May through September and doesn't feel that he can remain as active as he would like to. We also received notice that Brian and Cindy LeBlanc are moving out of state and will no longer be members of the department. We have processed 3 new applications from Jamie Ferguson, Terry Domer and Alix Greenleaf. All 3 have completed the hiring process and will be starting the beginning of October.

Apparatus: The specs on the mini pumper are very close to completion which will allow us to get this truck ordered and in production. Expected date of completion is 140 days after the chassis arrives at any of factories. Chassis supply right now is a hit or miss proposition. Until an order is placed none of the manufacturers are committing any chassis they might have or have on order. Vehicle maintenance has performed the fall service on all of our vehicles and we are beginning our winter preparations

Equipment: Nothing to report

Training: The department is working on several area trainings and initiatives with our mutual aid partners that will benefit all departments. We have scheduled a weekend training on water supply for next spring, we have a Maine Fire Institute Instructor 1 program in progress which will wrap up in early December, we are working on setting up a basic 100 hour FF school to train new recruits as several area departments have some new personnel, in conjunction with our mutual aid departments we are working to set up a peer support group, with members from each department, that could come in and assist a department that might be dealing with a critical incident type of call. This could be a traumatizing medical call, member death, mass casualty incident etc.

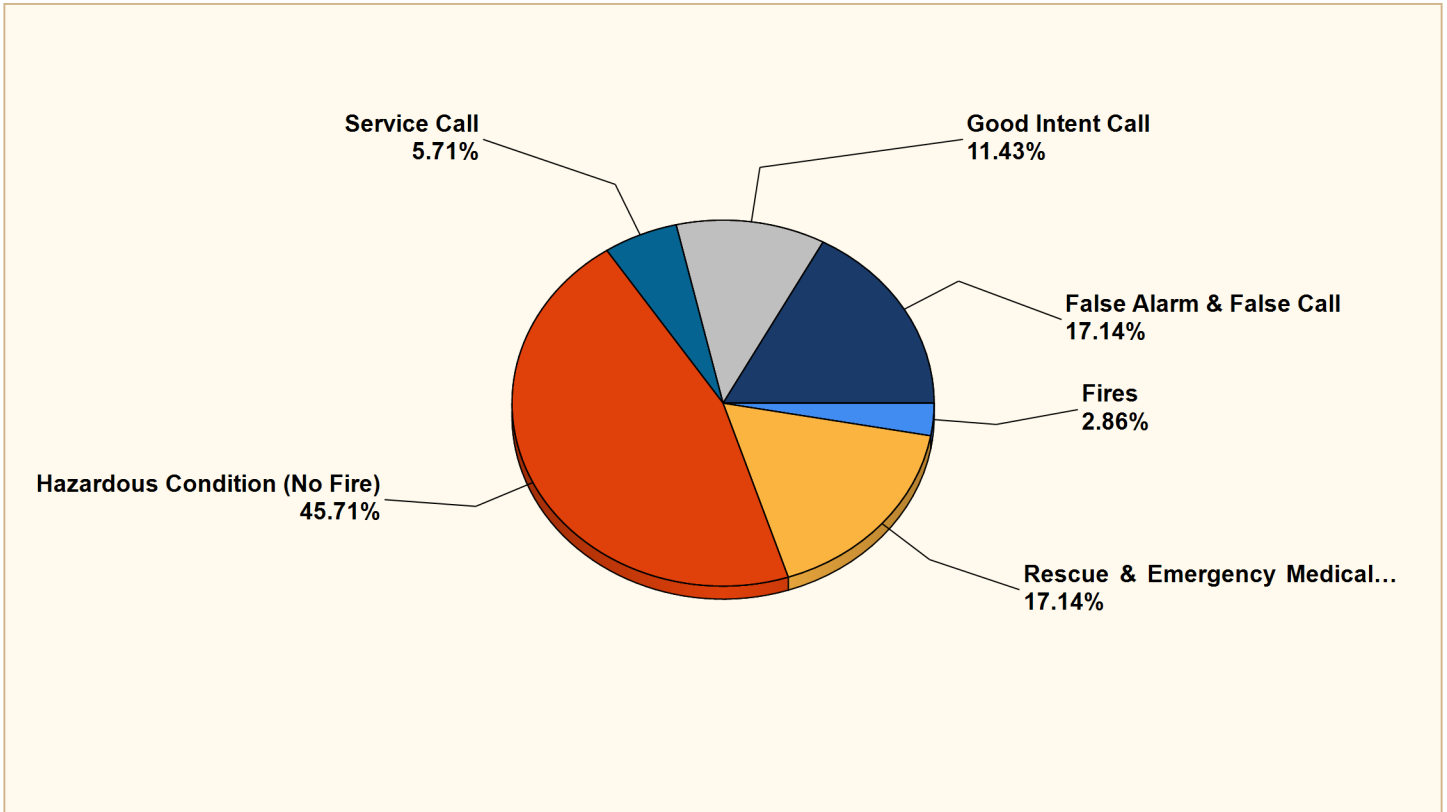
