**DECEMBER**

**Parks Crew & Wastewater**

- Parks performed all weekly maintenance throughout the month
- Worked at the Town Hall to fix the sewer issue out to the septic tank
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; billed out quarterly sewer accounts
- Parks worked on decorating the town for Christmas
- Helped clean up from a small storm the week of December 12<sup>th</sup> and prepped for a bigger storm looming for the end of that same week
- Plowed snow and cleaned up from major storm
- Chipped branches and cut up trees from second major storm
- Assisted highway with road repair as well after the storms
- Wastewater read and documented the pump station readings weekly; grounds maintenance was completed around pump stations as needed
- Safety training provided to Public Works, Parks & T.S. employees. Done monthly.
- Wastewater assisted Kyle Warren with a problem at the Wayside pump station
- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- Continued to follow up on septic tank pumping reminders

- Highway worked on decorating the town for Christmas along with Parks and Cemetery staff
- Documented fuel readings at garage pumps for billing purposes
- Chris L completed his CDL
- Fixed GFI's on light poles
- Cleaned leaves around the town office
- Prepped and cleaned plow trucks for storms
- Plowed and sanded during storms
- Brushing on Wildwood
- Cleaned up trees from storms
- Fixed many washouts on various roads
- Sent out a chip crew for downed trees and limbs
- Fixed washouts with the grader

- Cemeteries worked on decorating the town for Christmas
- Removed the road signs from Forest Hills
