Monthly Report for October 2022:

Personnel: The department currently is working with our new members to get them up to speed with basic initial training, BOLS training and overall orientation

Training: The department is looking at online computer based programs that we could use for our administrative type training such as the training required by the Bureau of Labor Standards and other training that can be done online or with some online along with some hands on time. Fire extinguishers would be one example of this type of training. We believe this will lead to greater compliance on the mandatories as personnel can complete the training on their schedule vs having to be at the station at a specific time and date.

Apparatus: Engine 1 has a corrosion issue on the frame which vehicle maintenance is monitoring very closely for any signs that the corrosion is getting to the point of having to take the truck out of service. The truck is a 2004 and it is doubtful that we will be able to get the full 25 year life out of that vehicle. If there are any changes in the situation I will update the board.

Activities: The last Music on Main was held in October. Great event with no public safety issues. Your public safety team will work with the ordinance Review Committee for some updates on the Outdoor Festival Ordinance.


