Town Attorney, Jim Katsiaficas, spoke to sensitive uses and safe zones. He stated that the Board has the authority to grant this variance only if it passes the Undue Hardship Test.

The Board deliberated to see if the variance request would pass the Undue Hardship Test. The 4 subjects of the test are as follows:

- 1. The land in question cannot yield a reasonable return unless a variance is granted
- 2. The need for a variance is due to the unique circumstances of the property and not to the general conditions in the neighborhood
- 3. The granting of the variance will not alter the essential character of the locality
- 4. The hardship is not the result of action taken by the applicant or a prior owner
