## Bridgton Public Services Department Monthly Activity Report for January 2023



### **Parks Crew & Wastewater**

- Parks performed all weekly maintenance throughout the month
- All departments involved in snow cleanup from storms, and during the week.
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; billed out quarterly sewer accounts
- All departments continued with chipping & plowing snow from storms.
- Wastewater read and documented the pump station readings weekly; grounds maintenance was completed around pump stations as needed
- Assisted in removing trees and branches from roadsides
- Safety training provided to Public Works, Parks & T.S. employees. Done monthly.
- All departments worked on plowing snow and cleaning up from weekly storms. Helped with snow removal and shelving of snowbanks throughout town.
- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- All departments helped with snow removal on North & South High Streets plus the intersection of Main and 117
- Continued to follow up on septic tank pumping reminders

- Fixed Camp Pondicherry washout

- Put down hot mix on roads
