Personnel

As we look ahead at the new year, our staff began the task of annual performance reviews and goal setting. Each staff member met with and was evaluated by their immediate supervisor.

Officer George attended a two-day training on Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs.

PSAA Pelletier and Officer McCloud attended a quarterly meeting with Through These Doors and Cumberland County Sheriff's office to discuss the ongoing grant we are operating under. Through this grant, Officer McCloud conducts extra follow up and investigative efforts on Domestic Violence cases as well as conducts compliance checks on those who have been arrested for DV related crimes and/or have active protection orders against them.

Officers Chaine received accolades for his efforts with Wreaths Across America. He has also been working steadily on updating and reviewing the police departments evidence/property storage room.

Officers continue to assist those in our community who struggle with mental health related problems. We are looking forward to the deployment of our mental health liaison in partnership with Opportunity Alliance.

Chief Jones, Sgt. Reese, and Officer Chaine continue to work on initiating the K9 program. We are currently ordering equipment and locating a suitable K9 with the assistance of the Maine State Police K9 academy staff. All cost has been covered by the Stanton Foundation Grant.

Chief Jones presented to the First Congregational Church at their Sunday morning service on the topic of Homeless in our region.

Other

The Department is close to being ready to apply for accreditation through the Maine Law Enforcement Accreditation Program (MLEAP). This will be the culmination of two years of efforts put forth updating and instituting policies, procedures, and practices.
