Monthly Report for March 2023

The following is the monthly report for the Bridgton Fire Department for March 2023:

Personnel: The department is continuing our annual required refresher training for all employees. This usually involves several sessions including makeup sessions for folks that might have missed the original session due to work, sickness etc. We will also be holding our annual awards banquet on April 29th beginning at 5:30 pm at Pleasant Mt. This is also the last day of the Basic Firefighter School for 4 of our new employees who will have completed approximately 150 hrs of training in basic firefighting. This last day these folks will be participating in live fire burns at the Hollis Training Facility and I'm sure will show up with fantastic appetites after a hard day of firefighting.

Buildings: Spring cleaning in all stations has begun. As the weather warms I will be coordinating with Public Works to get some minor siding repairs done on the North and South Stations.

Apparatus: We finally have a Ford 550 chassis allocated to our mini pumper project. Obtaining these chassis is a project in and of itself. I do not know when the chassis will arrive at our builder's factory but when it does it will take approximately six months to complete from there. We continue to monitor the corrosion issue on E-1's frame. It has not progressed to the point where we have to take it off the road. The mechanic is continuing to treat the frame with a product called Fluid Film which seems to have slowed the progression. That being said the replacement for this truck will have to be a priority in the FY 24-25 budget, keeping in mind that once a truck is ordered it is still 24+ months till that truck will be delivered.


