Parks Crew & Wastewater

- All departments involved in snow cleanup multiple times throughout the month
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; billed out quarterly sewer accounts
- Helped highway with patching, traffic control and brushing
- Wastewater read and documented the pump station readings weekly; grounds maintenance was completed around pump stations as needed
- Finished building the wall in garage over at the Ham Complex
- Safety training provided to Public Works, Parks & T.S. employees. Done monthly.
- Built shelves in garage at the Ham complex for the Rec Department
- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- Set up and teardown for elections
