Parks Crew & Wastewater

- All departments started spring clean up in the parks by picking up branches, leaves and sand
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; billed out quarterly sewer accounts

- Wastewater read and documented the pump station readings weekly; grounds maintenance was completed around pump stations as needed
