Selectboard Report:

Selectboard meeting last night:

- -Holden Hills North Bridgton Private driveway damage from public plowing and it was repaired and fixed by the town.
- -Discussed selling property at Christmas Tree Shores on Sleigh Bell Lane. It was decided to wait to see what happens with COMP and Open Spade plans. Property worth \$600k
- -It was decided to keep town meetings capped appropriation warrant article
- -A motion was passed to increase the sewer rate.

Town Manager Report:

- -TM feels selectboard made right decision on fixing driveway in Holden Hills
- -Amusement permit was granted to Stella's for outside dining and music
- -Lake Level Policy select board agreed to bring lakes to winter level on November instead of October
- -Road work on Bennett, Kenard and Bacon, manhole covers are being raised for final paving. Should be done in June.
- -Wastewater treatment facility is moving along.
- -Sidewalks on Highland Road are almost done. Railing along Mill Pond being installed, reconfiguring boat parking due to pedestrian impact and safety.
- -Bathrooms at Highland Lake are completed and will be open by Memorial Day Chamber will work on a ribbon cutting

- -Town will have cameras installed at both Highland Lake and Woods Pond and Salmon Point as well.
- -Elm Street Sidewalk has started and coming along nicely
- -Evening work on North High Street will not start until Monday due to this week's weather
- -New sidewalks on Main Street will have a concrete section with granite covering to keep with the Main Streetscape. Church Street will be the same as well.
