Personnel

Officer Hammond, who had worked for the department since 2015, tendered his resignation. We wish him all the best in his future efforts.

Due to a variety of factors, we found ourselves with to be below minimum staffing levels. In an effort to encourage our officers to continue their outstanding efforts and to compensate them for the added time put in to keep 24/7 patrol coverage, the town and union have agreed to a short-term retention bonus and added compensation for working overtime to fill vacancies. Chief Jones is also filling shifts that are not taken by officers in order to decrease any forced overtime (order ins).

At the close of April, Officer Chaine and K9 Gibbs have completed seven weeks of patrol K9 training.

Chief Jones had the opportunity to speak at the Community Center Senior Lunch, presenting on current fraud issues and answering questions (not to mention sharing in the delicious meal).

Officer McCloud presented to local bank staff on security response and situational awareness.

Officer Chaine took part in the regularly scheduled Drug Take Back event, he also manages the collection box which is located in the PD lobby and available during business hours.

This month we welcomed our new Mental Health Police Liaison, Kortnie Sanchez, to the team. She is a Opportunity Alliance mobile crisis worker who is based out of and coresponder with the PD.
