## Bridgton Public Services Department Monthly Activity Report for May 2023



### **Parks Crew & Wastewater**

- Major storm week of May 1 caused a lot of damage with 5 inches of rain - all crews worked on repairing washouts and deploying barriers/cones at trouble spots
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; billed out quarterly sewer accounts
- Week of May 8<sup>th</sup> all crews continued working to clean up and repair more of the damage from last week's storm
- Wastewater read and documented the pump station readings weekly; grounds maintenance was completed around pump stations as needed
- Glenn, Doug and Jeremy worked with Lucia on the town gardens
- Safety training provided to Public Works, Parks & T.S. employees. Done monthly.
- Howard worked with the contractors on the wastewater project throughout the month, and performed inspections
- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- Doug continued with his weekly mowing schedule
- Jeremy & Glenn mowed the HAM complex

### **About Town ... Highway Road Crew**

- Repaired numerous washouts after the rain storms
- Culvert work
- Repaired numerous roads, potholes, drainage ditches, etc., again from the rain storms
- Harmon Road, repaired and graded, installed new culvert
- Repaired Burnham Road from major washout
- Moved boat launch at Highland Beach
- 2 of the crew worked flagging for crosswalks
- Rebuilt Winn Road, ditched and fixed washouts
- Sweeping
- Installed private road signs
- Fixed Bayberry / washout / 2 driveway culverts / rip rap / new culvert
- Prepped for mowing week / washed the equipment
- Mowed and weed whacked cemeteries with Parks crew
- Put in Highland Docks and put out the tables

- Picked up sweeper piles
- Fixed washout on Bear Pond Road
- Graded Millbrook and Jim Douglass
- Completed culvert on Ingalls Road

#### **Cemeteries ...**

- All departments participated in mowing and weed whacking of cemeteries in preparation for Memorial Day

#### **Transfer Station ...**

- Weekly auctions
- The store is doing well, and has picked up
- Constant can changes have been increasing for a total of 44 cans – 18 trash, 9 recycling, 11 demo and 6 metal
- As always, constant picking up and cleaning around the facility
- Paint was picked up on 5/18/2023
- We did some preventative maintenance on 5/12/2023
- The scale was calibrated on 5/22/2023
- Salvation Army is still doing a great job with emptying the bins each week
- Freon was drained from the items out back. We are waiting for a can to dispose of the scrap metal.
