Parks Crew & Wastewater

- All monthly reports were done, including posting to the website pages
- Glen and Jeremy worked with Lucia and mowed the Ham sports complex
- Wastewater recorded weekly meter readings
- Worked on getting Ham field ready for the softball tournament
- Reminders and 30-day notices sent out; billed out quarterly sewer accounts

- Replaced culvert at 511 Kansas Road
- Cleaned up Meadow Street tree
- Dug Highland trench
- Patched around town
- Unclogged culverts
- Re-ditched Zion Hill Road and graded the dirt portion
- Replaced 100' of culvert on Grist Mill Road and removed some stumps
- Fixed washout on Willis Park & Burnham Roads
- Finished all of Grist Mill work
- Hauled 16 loads of gravel
- Safety training provided to all staff – done monthly
- Ditched Ray Whitney Road
- Painted Depot Street and Highland crosswalks
- Completed the grading on Zion Hill Road
- Ditched Fosterville Road and marked out culverts
- Hauled stone, gravel and rip rap
- Replaced culvert at 192 Fosterville Road
