Completed Work over the Previous Two Weeks

- Continued WWTF and pump stations' resident inspections.

- Submitted work order for concept plan design for Transfer Station Improvements.
- Continued design work on sewer extension project.
- Completed survey work for Wildwood Culvert replacement.
- Attended construction meeting for WWTF and pump stations on November 21st at 10am.
- Worked with MEH representatives to get information on installed utilities along Efficiency and Sustainable Way for the sewer extension project.
- Aerial survey of Norridgewock did fly over of mountain road drainage area.
- Solicited additional contractors for installation of monitoring wells.

Anticipated Work over the Next Two Weeks

- Continue WWTF and pump stations resident inspections.
- Meet with Town to review sewer extension project.
- Complete work on spreadsheet identifying individual user connection quantities.

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- Complete Church Street Sidewalk design for bid solicitation and set bid dates.
- Submit Church Street sidewalk detail around utility pole for Town review.

- Work with Town on MDOT response to Depot Street bridge work.
