

Bridgton Public Services Department Monthly Activity Report for December 2023



Parks Crew & Wastewater

- Week of 12/3: Wastewater recorded weekly meter readings and assisted with pump stations and plant start-up; reminder notices were done for all overdue sewer accounts and reports on pump station were forwarded to the DEP.
- Week of 12/10: Wastewater recorded weekly meter readings and assisted with pump stations and plant start-up; monthly safety training provided to all staff.
- Week of 12/17: Wastewater recorded weekly meter readings and attended training sessions in preparation for the start-up of the plant.
- Week of 12/24: Wastewater recorded weekly meter readings and helped with starting up the plant and receiving flow from the town. Also, attended more training.

About Town ... Highway Road Crew

- Week of 12/3: Dug up the septic tank at the old Town Hall; prepped for the Christmas parade; plowed all day from the snowstorm; started cleaning the trucks from the storm; picked up branches from the roadsides; did snow removal and brushed/chipped branches from the storm; wood chipper down for maintenance; assisted Larry in cleaning out the tomb; cleaned out culverts before the storm; greased various equipment; welded broken plows.
- Week of 12/10: Cleaned up after storm; fixed washouts from the storm; sanded roads at 4:30 am; went to North Bridgton to brush the roadsides; cleared trees on Bear Pond Road to make the road wider; finished taking trees down on Bear Pond and went on to stumping; OFF on Friday; monthly safety training provided to all staff.
- Week of 12/17: Checked for storm damage; unclogged culverts; started the process of storm clean-up; took care of various washouts in town; excavator used on Fosterville Road for large washout; wood-chipped downed trees from the storm; fixed small Mountain Road washout and one on Kansas Road.
- Week of 12/24: Came in on Christmas Eve to sand the roads; Christmas holiday OFF; continued storm clean-up and repaired various small washouts; removed tree debris on Mountain Road and Hio Ridge Rd; put up two new road signs; continued fixing Bear Pond Rd; hooked up plows for the storm.
