Monthly Report – February 2024

Winter is waning and spring is on the horizon! Our crews have been hard at work continuing their plowing, road treatment and snow removal where needed. In addition, the crews have remained diligent in maintaining the equipment to ensure we are always prepared for the next storm. Between patching potholes, fixing road signs, brushing throughout town, our team is constantly in motion improving our roadways. Our team has expanded their spring clean up to include clearing out the beach at Highland Lake and will continue to prepare our beaches for the upcoming season.

The transfer station has continued their work cleaning up the interior and exterior of the facility in preparation for spring. Can changeover has remained slow with a total of 33 cans. (15 trash, 11 recycling, 4 demo, 3 metal) All electronics and televisions have been shipped out as of February 2nd. As before, the Salvation Army has been coming to empty the donation bins regularly. Please be sure to donate whenever possible to ensure that we are not adding unnecessary items to our Municipal Solid Waste. In addition, the Transfer Station Store continues to do well, and their social media following is still growing steadily!

Following the successful startup of our Wastewater Treatment Facility, the operable pump stations are flowing correctly, and we anticipate the same success with the rest of the pump stations. Our team has been working alongside the contractors on finishing touches to our treatment facility. We have added a portable generator to our lineup to ensure full operation of the pump stations in the event of a power outage.
