Since winter has decided to stick around a little longer, our crews have continued their hard work towards keeping our roadways clear and safe. Our crew masterfully cleared over two feet of snow that fell within a 24-hour period. We commend them for a job well done! Aside from plowing, our crew has been executing various road repairs throughout town as needed. Additional road repairs are being planned and will begin once the weather permits. Our mechanics have been performing spring servicing on all town vehicles, including the Fire & Police vehicles. Spring cleanup of our parks and beaches will continue as the snow fades.

The Transfer Station has continued their spring-cleaning efforts despite the recent snowstorm. The Salvation Army continues to collect donations weekly and the Transfer Station Store is thriving and continues to grow its sizeable social media following! The weekly auctions are a perpetual success as well. Please be sure to donate whenever possible to minimize unnecessary contributions to the Municipal Solid Waste. Can changeover has picked up for a total of 38 cans this month. Paint was picked up on 3/19 and we closed early on 3/23 due to the major storm. The Transfer Station will no longer be accepting construction material for re-sale.

Our Wastewater Treatment Facility continues to run smoothly. The deconstruction of obsolete tanks has begun, and the start-up of our Park Street pump station is well underway. In addition to ensuring the Wastewater Treatment Facility continues to perform as expected, our Water Reclamation Foreman has completed continuing education courses in Kansas to better serve the Town of Bridgton.
